- Teach students to grow their own food organically and sustainably, so that they can pass on their gardening skills to others.
- Guide students through propagation, planting, cultivation, maintenance, and harvesting of seasonal food crops. Demonstrate best practices.
- Assist students with developing garden-oriented programming for the club and college community.
- Advise students and oversee maintenance of compost bins and worm compost system.
- Advise students and demonstrate fruit tree care, pruning, irrigation, feeding, and harvesting.
- Supervise student(s) who maintain the garden seed library.
- Assist Club Managers as an advisor/consultant regarding garden supplies and materials needed.
- Present brief hands-on gardening demonstrations at Club Grow meetings.
- Adhere to SMC policies to assure safety and security on campus.
- Perform other related duties as determined.

Time Commitment

- Attend monthly student garden manager meetings 1.5 hours month
