The current job involves removing about 100 to 150 cubic feet of soil (about 3 to 5 cubic yards) from a backyard using manual tools (shovel, pick, hand mattock, wheelbarrow, etc.) then moving replacement soil back into the area. Soil will be hauled away by a separate party.
- The location is near the ocean, so temperatures are normally in the 70s when inland areas are in the 90s to over 100.
- I'm looking for a physically strong and self-motivated worker who will be hired and paid whole check for independent-contract work directly by my client (not employment).
- The position requires a person who works efficiently as instructed without constant supervision, and who can do heavy landscape labor all day without tiring.
- Must be fluent in English, have reliable transportation, and take full responsibility for all aspects of running your own independent business.
- Future additional work is likely if performance is good for this job.

- Strength and endurance for heavy landscape labor.
- Caring about trees and sensitivity about minimizing damage to sycamore roots while soil is being removed.
