Covering topics like when and how to prune and fertilize natives, most common pests and soil problems, and how to irrigate young and older native plants, this plant will give you the skills and confidence to maintain your low-water garden all year long! Antonio Sanchez has over 15 years experience in native plant horticulture and sustainable agriculture, and has led native plant workshops across the state. Antonio was co-founder of Nopalito Native Plant Nursery in Ventura, formerly managed the nurseries at Rancho Santa Ana Botanic Garden in Claremont, and has worked at the Theodore Payne Foundation in Sun Valley, Cal Flora Nursery in Fulton, and the Santa Barbara Botanic Garden in Santa Barbara. He is currently the Nursery Manager and Resource Management Volunteer Coordinator at Rancho Sierra Vista nursery located in the Santa Monica Mountains Recreation Area.
