10-14-21, 710pm, Online Zoom, Growing Weed in the Garden with Johanna Silver

Description = Southern California Horticultural Society hosts Johanna Silver discussing her book on cannabis, *Growing Weed in the Garden*. Johanna Silver, former Sunset magazine garden editor, will share her journey into cannabis. Spoiler - she's not a stoner. Her program will include a brief history of the plant; its evolution and the current state of the plant's genetics; as well as addressing - and correcting - some myths and misinformation regarding cultivation. Silver's approach is outdoor-only and garden-scale because she grows for a love of the plant, not with the goal of maximizing yield, using simple tried-and-true techniques.

In addition to having spent ten years at Sunset, Silver has also published two books, *Growing Weed in the Garden: A No-Fuss, Seed-to-Stash Guide to Outdoor Cannabis Cultivation* (Abrams, 2020) and *The Bold Dry Garden: Lessons from the Ruth Bancroft Garden* (Timber Press, 2017). Among other current endeavors, she is a contributing editor at *Better Homes & Gardens* magazine and gardens in Berkeley, California, growing fruits, veggies, and entirely too many cut flowers.
