

Garden Event

10-7-22 through 10-9-22, In Person, Arroyo Permaculture Convergence, Altadena

Description = A weekend camping event with hands-on workshops and lectures intended to facilitate community education and growth through regenerative activities. Workshops will cover topics such as natural building, placemaking, animal husbandry & processing, soil microbiology and composting, friction fire, native & edible plant identification, primitive skills, fiber arts, meat preservation, fungal culturing, and food forestry. Included with your registration are two breakfasts and dinners. We will kick off the weekend on Friday night by sharing a potluck dinner. We welcome you to bring a dish or drink to share. Saturday and Sunday night dinners will be provided for you and made from homegrown ingredients. There will be locally sourced eggs available on Saturday & Sunday mornings. Attendees are welcome to cook eggs for themselves and friends on our DIY brick rocket stoves. Fermented foods and drinks will also be available throughout the weekend. Be sure to pack lunch for each day and bring a water bottle, as well as a plate/bowl and utensils. Complimentary camping is available onsite, however there are limited campsites and will be available until we reach capacity - so make sure to register early and let us know if you'd like to camp!

Cost = \$200-\$400 (sliding scale). These funds go toward compensating our educators, materials, facilities, and food. Limited work trade is available, as well.
