Come learn the basics of growing your own vegetables through the [Grow LA Gardens Initiative](#), a series of four-week classes offered around Los Angeles County. This fall, these

low-cost classes will be offered at [9 sites from Pomona to Long Beach](#). Our Van Nuys location at the Central Lutheran Church will be holding the class series in Spanish - see below for details.

Experienced *UC Master Gardener volunteers* lead the small classes where participants learn the ins-and-outs of soil preparation, irrigation, planting, pest management, and harvesting. In addition to learning the basics of successful gardening, participants meet other gardeners in their community and build a new network of



gardening friends. We will be offering classes in-person and as a hybrid (in-person, virtual).

Al completar las cuatro clases, los participantes recibirán un certificado en horticultores de legumbres (UC-certified Vegetable Gardeners).

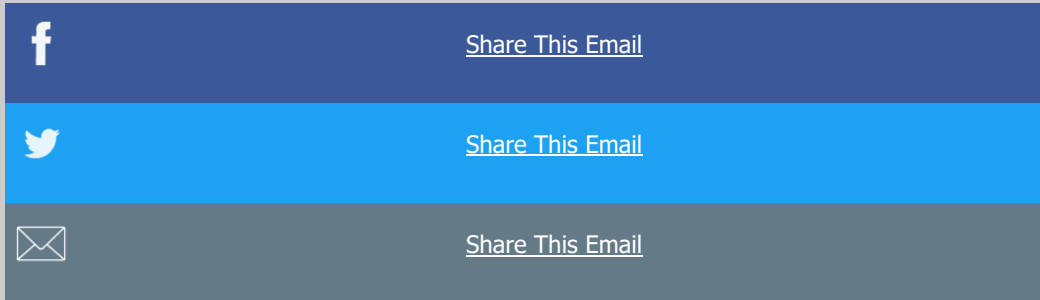
